

THE BETSY ULMER SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship Description:

Established in 2022, the Betsy Ulmer Scholarship was created to support the advancement of high school girls' golf to which Betsy dedicated her life as a founder, coach, competitor, teacher, and mentor for girls throughout Western New York. The Betsy Ulmer Scholarship is granted annually through the Buffalo District Golf Association to a female high school senior that has played golf in high school and plans to play collegiate golf. The scholarship award is a one-time amount of \$5,000.

Scholarship Criteria:

To be eligible for the scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Must be a female high school senior who has played golf in high school.
- 2. High School Academics will be considered.
- 3. Must submit at least one letter of recommendation (maximum of three) highlighting golf experience and contributions to Western New York's golfing community.
