- 1. Ties** - Ties for prizes (both net and gross) will be broken utilizing the USGA recommended method of matching scorecards (compare scorecards for final 9, if tie still exists compare final 6, and so on).
- 2. Duplicate Prizes** - Players are only eligible to win a single prize (gross or net). If a player earns two prizes, the higher value prize will be the one awarded. If the prizes are of equal value, then the gross prize will be awarded.
- 3. Prize Distribution** - 60% of each flight's prize purse is used for net prizes and the remaining 40% is used for gross prizes. Net and gross prizes are awarded at the flight level.
- 4. Unclaimed Prizes** - The NYSGA is not responsible for unclaimed prizes.
